Hawke's Bay Biodiversity Accord

The Hawke's Bay Biodiversity Strategy seeks to unite organisations to work together to ensure Hawke's Bay's biodiversity is enhanced, healthy and functioning now and for future generations.

It is the first opportunity in our region's history that all of the people involved in biodiversity have come together, agreeing that something better needs to be done. After the Strategy, the next step beyond the Accord is putting this work into action. Partners and Friends to this Accord have signalled their commitment to the Vision of the Hawke's Bay Biodiversity Strategy.

Objectives of the Hawke's Bay Biodiversity Strategy

Native habitats We will sustain, protect and improve native habitats

and the ecosystem services they provide.

Native species We will sustain, protect, and improve populations

of native species.

Maori values We will recognise indigenous biodiversity as a taonga

to be protected for future generations.

Partnerships We will collaborate effectively, align programmes and

share responsibilities to achieve biodiversity outcomes.

Community We will support education, engagement, care for the environment 'kaitiakitanga', and actively connect our

community through biodiversity programmes.



Accountable Partners

They are accountable for delivering objectives and outcomes set by the Strategy, and their accountabilities will be reflected and revised*. They carry out these responsibility in good faith and to the best of their abilities.
